

**Minutes**

Approximately 11 members were in attendance.

2. A discussion concerning plans to install the Mosley beam on the roof of the Pentagon followed. A Baird mount or tower/elevator mount are the two options being considered at this time. AA6FX recommended a forty foot tower and mentioned the possibility of installing a loop antenna as an alternative to the beam antenna. Remote operation of the beam was also mentioned as an option where the distance between the station and antenna location was great.

The next meeting will be at noon Wednesday, 4 January 2006, in room 2C554.

Meeting will be devoted to Rick Low's analysis of required height of the Mosley beam antenna.
