Minutes Pentagon Amateur Radio Club July 7, 2010

The meeting was chaired by club president Dr. Gene Kaiser and called to order at 12:03 PM. Introductions of members present were made.

Mr. Phil Kania gave a report on the PARC American Radio Relay League (ARRL) Field Day activities conducted on June 26th in conjunction with the Arlington Amateur Radio Club.

Mr. Gary Sessums briefed the group on the DoD communications exercise involving military airborne assets that took place on June 11th. The Pentagon Military Auxiliary Radio System (MARS) Station was able to provide both voice and data communications support to DoD units during the exercise.

Dr. Kaiser reported that Mr. Bob Lipp and Mr. Ben Baddley have repaired the Drake L7 amplifier power supply by replacing damaged capacitors and diodes in the unit. The amplifier has been tested and is now operational once again. They will next tackle the repair of the Ten-Tec Titan 425 linear amplifier.

A report was given on the status of the resurfacing of the Pentagon roof and the effect of the project on the MARS station antennas. MARS personnel are working with DoD Washington Headquarters Service employees and the roofing contractor to minimize any downtown required by movement of antennas to facilitate roofing work.
